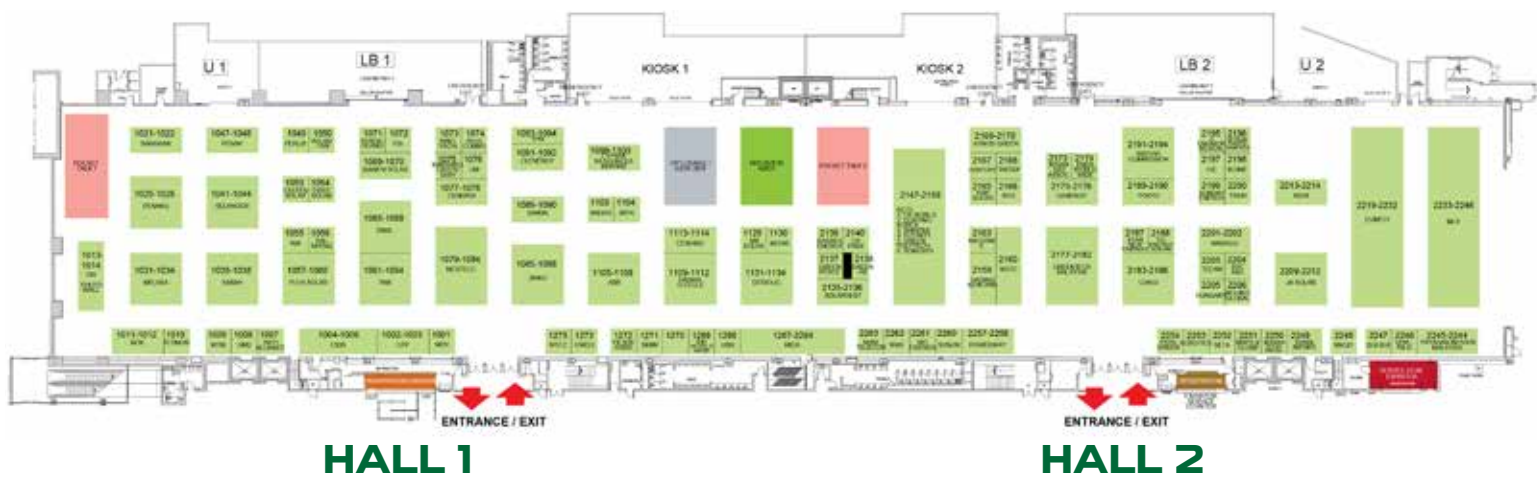





OVERALL FLOOR PLAN

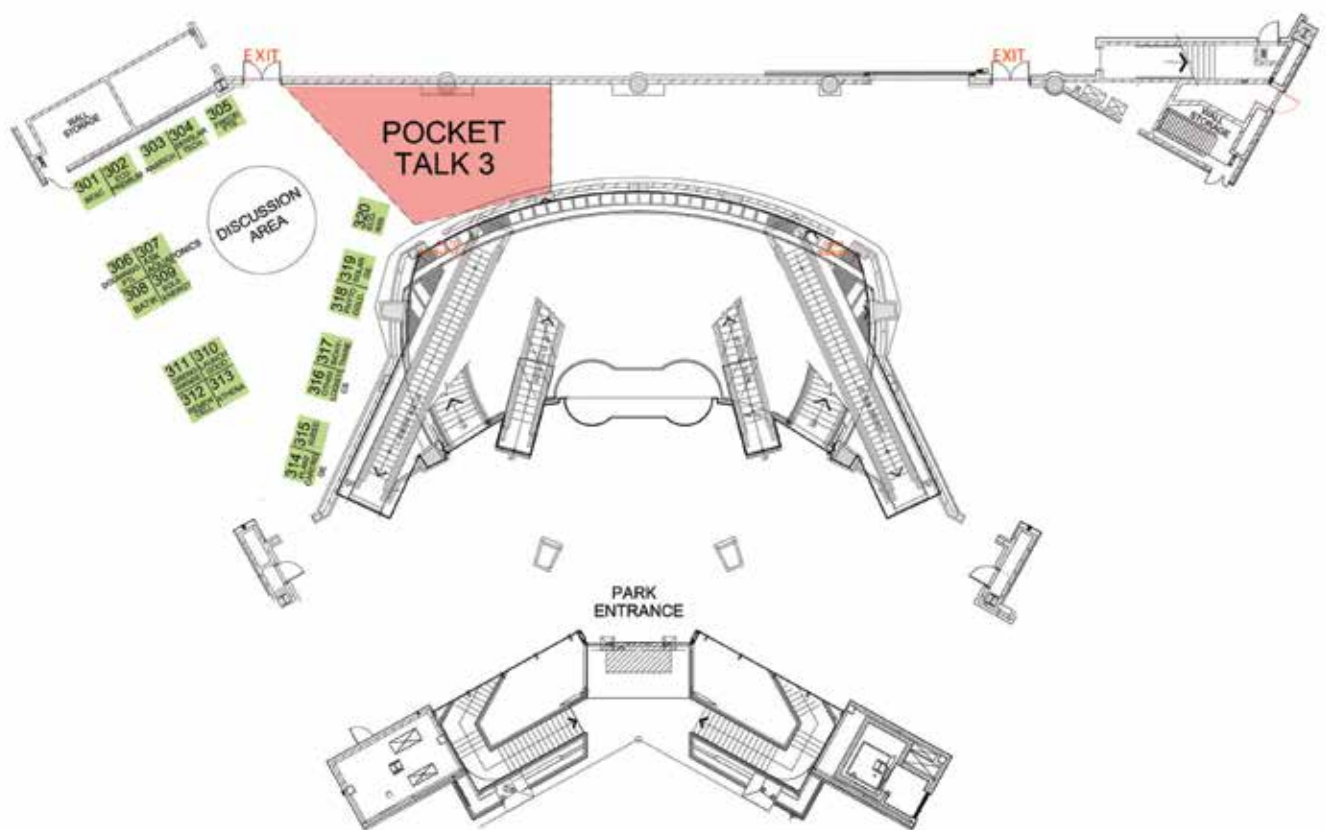

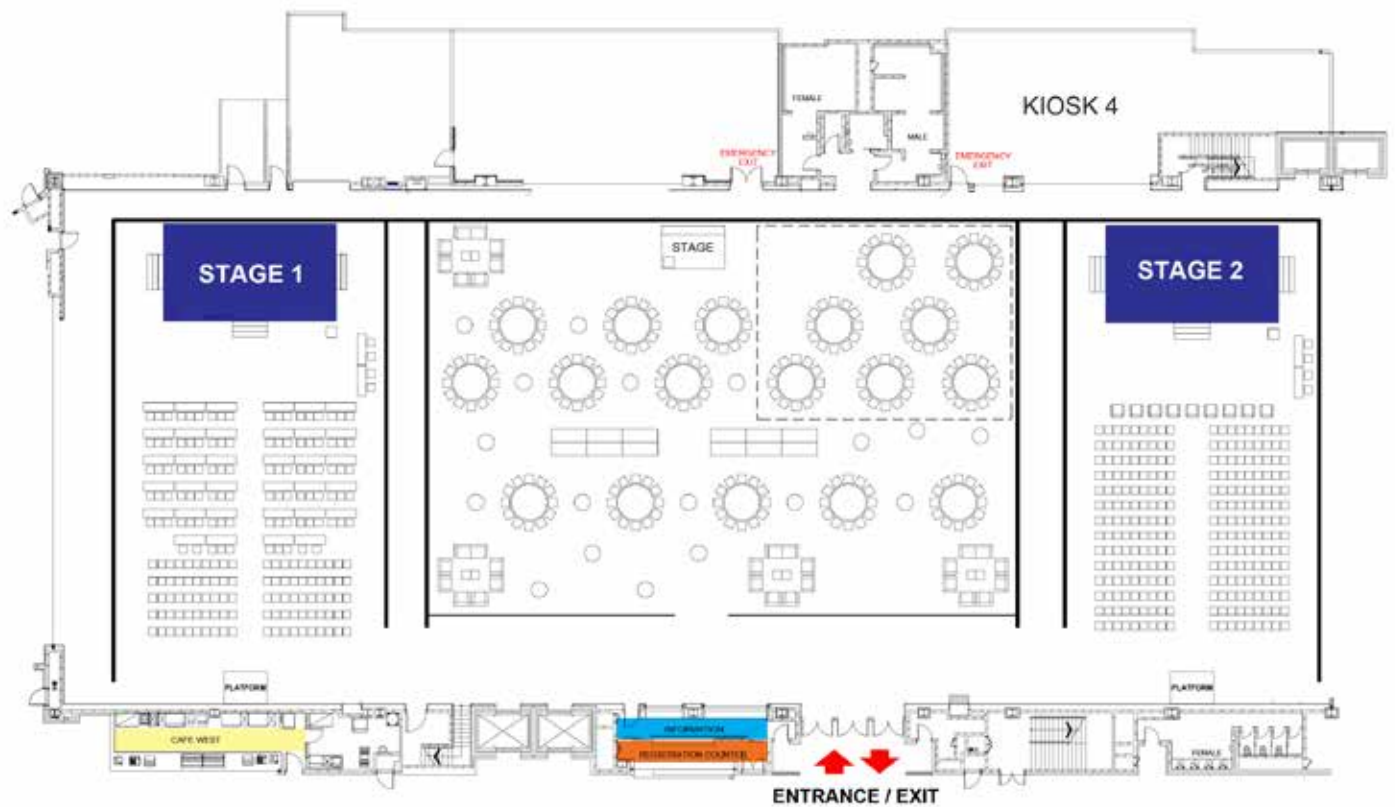

A Qibla finder with recent electro-mechanical technology. InnoQibla is a stand-alone highly-technological device. It is less susceptible to various external factors, highly precise at the rate of 3degree variance. The proposed technology would eliminate the dependency on the sun as a reference by determining Qibla direction from a specific point read by a sensor within InnoQibla. The sensor would detect the signal produced from the earth movement, compile its information and feed into a microcomputer processing unit. The control element developed for this system is in the form of feedback proportional-integral-derivative controller (PID controller). The microcomputer then gives instruction to the motorized laser to point at the Qibla direction for that point under investigation.

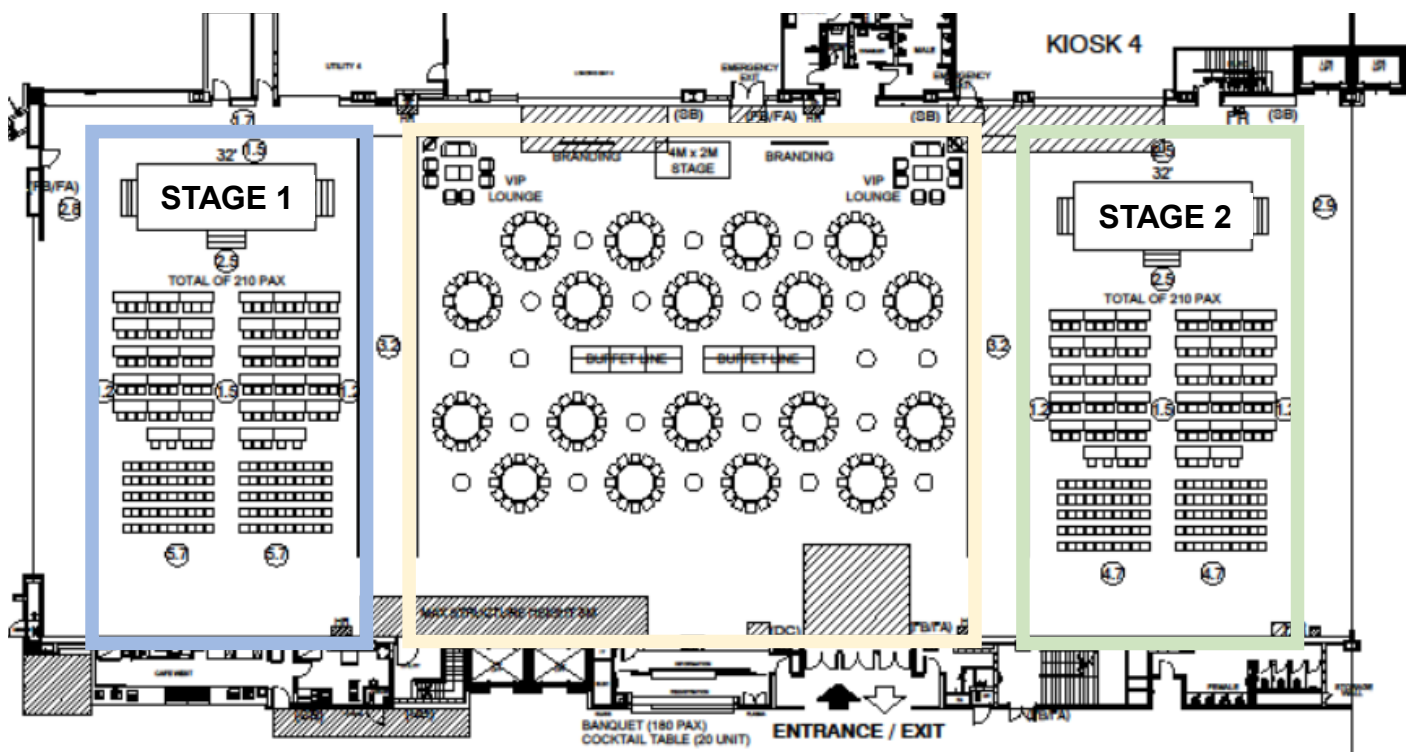

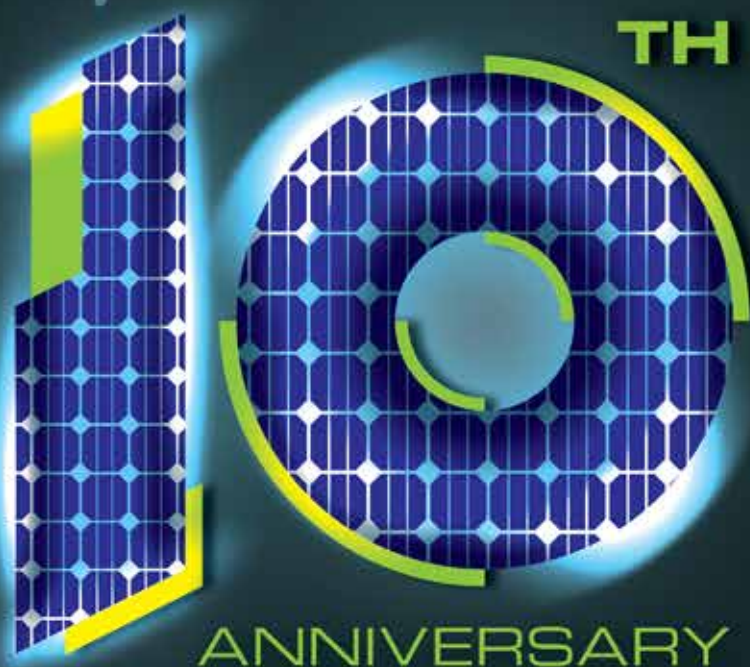
